## Activity Instructions

This activity can even be played virtually with a friend or in a group!

**All you need are two blank pieces of paper and two different coloured markers.**

- On your first blank sheet of paper, with a coloured marker, write the word "REAL".
- On a separate blank sheet of paper using a different coloured marker, now write the word "FAKE".
- Before reading the headlines, make sure to designate only one person as the "Headliner" to read the headlines and have the answer key.
- This person will read each headline and ask the group to determine whether they believe the story is real or fake.
- Each person will hold up their "Real" sign or "Fake" sign and the Headliner will provide the answer.
